School-Directed Individual Home Instruction

This program involves the student remaining at home, with assignments in the form of packets. (Guardians pick up assignments and drop off completed work.) Students are responsible to schedule tests for each of the subjects with the counseling office.

Electronic High School

This method of obtaining partial high school credit is free for Utah residents. Students sign up on their computer at home and do assignments and tests over the internet. It is the responsibility of the student and parent to check with the school to make sure that the class will be accepted for credit by the local high school. Upon completion, students should bring their certification with their grade to the registrar so it can be entered for credit.

Partial Day Attendance

This program will release the student from Box Elder Middle School during _____ period(s). Box Elder Middle School is released of any obligation to this student (education, supervision, etc.) during this period(s). Also, the parent will have sole responsibility for their child's care and activities during this period. The parent also takes responsibility for bringing the student to and from school to accommodate this release time.

The student and parent(s) understand that withdrawal from conventional school programs at the 9th grade level has an impact on future graduation plans. **Any loss of credit or choice of less than a full schedule may make graduation with the student's class impossible.** Sunrise High School awards credit as usual, but does not offer any elective classes.

Any student who is on school campus during school hours must be registered for and attending classes. Students who are on campus at a time when they are not scheduled for classes violates school policy. The parent(s) must therefore assume responsibility for the supervision of the student during the time he/she is released from school. *The student must not be on Box Elder Middle School campus or on the streets, which are adjacent to the campus during the hour, or days they are released from school.*
